Περίληψη – εισαγωγή: (120 – 150 λέξεις):

Since 1996, the CYC has 27 years of life, full of activities, public service as an umbrella organization of G/C and T/C youth organizations and NGOs.

Unfortunately, so many years after its establishment and its activity, its institutionalization has not been achieved, which would provide CYC with the required recognition and upgrade.

Today, the institutionalization of CYC is considered necessary as never before, since we are facing developments which may be proven to be very dangerous.

On the one hand, the actions of the Cyprus president's office, to create a vague "Youth Advisory Group" for youth issues and on the other hand the actions of the Turkish Cypriot community to evolve the "Youth Forum" into a "Youth Council" make imperative the need for the registration of the Youth Council, as the institutionalized umbrella-organization, G/C and T/C, Youth Organisations and NGOs.

Θέσεις Πολιτικής: (σε μορφή bullet-point)

As CYC, we support:

- The adoption of a legislation that binds the state to:
 - Recognise the Cyprus Youth Council as the National Youth Council.
 - Produce youth policies.
 - Consult with the National Youth Council on youth and youth related issues.
- The creation, from CYC's side, of an ad-hoc committee that includes members of the current CYC board, former members of the previous boards, CYC legal advisor, with the aim of composing a comprehensive proposal for CYC institutionalization and the consultation with the competent state stakeholders in order to achieve of.
- Holding meetings with all relevant stakeholders to inform, promote and satisfy the request.
- Carrying out information activities on the issue.
- The CYC continues reaching out to T/C youth and youth organizations in order to inform about the action and the policy positions of the CYC as a representative of all the youth of Cyprus.

- The clear stance against any intolerant, nationalist action and/or organization that endangers the common, peaceful coexistence of the Cypriot people.
