- Implementation of the general plan for the beaches.
- Reinforcement of green spaces and introduction of strict environmental conditions in large developments.
- Prevention and training measures to deal with fires and other natural disasters.
- Encourage young people to invest in the recycling process
- Promoting the use of energy saving systems.

- Rational and sustainable utilization of Renewable Energy Sources.
- Proper environmental management of natural gas deposits, with strict rules on pollution of the marine environment.
- Full protection of the natural wealth located in the Natura 2000 network.
- Upgrading public transport.
- Respect and enforce all environmental laws, including respect and compliance with relevant environmental impact assessment projects. Imposition of severe penalties on offenders.
- Unified water management.
- Requirement for "Cyprus Free from Genetically Modified Organisms".
- Protection of biodiversity, proper management of mineral and water resources, preservation of air quality in combination with proper management of gaseous pollutant emissions and various waste streams.
